Because the groups have created the service structure, they have final authority over all its affairs. By the same token, the groups also have the final responsibility for the support of all its activities. The two go hand and

Motion 2<u>- To approve the IP contained in Addendum A," Mental Health in Recovery" as</u> <u>Fellowship approved recovery literature.</u> (...this is a very real issue for a lot of us in the rooms. Outside issues are not outside issues if they affect us on the inside.)

Motion 3<u>- To approve the revisions to the FIPT Operational Rules contained in Addendum B.</u> (...discussions regarding our literature and the use of the NA Service Symbol<u>)</u>

Motion 4<u>- To approve the revisions to NA Intellectual Property Bulletin #1 contained in</u> <u>Addendum C (discussions regarding permission being required for the reprinting/copying of</u> NA books)

Motion 5<u>- To approve the initiation of the established process to revise the Fellowship</u> <u>Intellectual Property Trust in the 2020-2022 Conference Cycle</u> (discussions regarding updates to the fellowship Intellectual Property Trust (FIPT))
