I'm an addict named Brad

I was voted in as the RCM for WMANA in April, 2025.

We have voted in the use of an app called WMANA.

It's available on Google play store and will be out on the Apple products soon.

We have voted yes for the three motions regarding the regions vision, purpose, and mission statements.

Literature

We have had issues with invoicing from NAWs for literature orders. We were about \$10,000 in arrears. We had been put hold as far as ordering anymore literature. This issue has been resolved thanks to Jennifer and Eleanor at NAWs. Apparently NAWs has been basically closed and were rotating people to cover empty positions within a skeleton crew.

H&I

Our efforts continue to grow with more facilities asking for H&I panels. However, we are limited by the amount of people we have to do them. We have received literature that was ordered in January for Winfield Correctional Facility. We are still selling t-shirts to raise funds for literature to go into prisons

PR

We are servicing 23 facilities in Wichita with meeting schedules, IP's, and White Books. We are scheduled to give a presentation at Bel Aire Outpatient Program on June 12th provided we have volunteers. We already missed an opportunity on May 1st because we had not volunteers. Humankind Ministries, who oversees the Homeless Shelter at the old Park School wants providers (us) to sign an agreement to go along with the rules for the shelter.

We discussed the Area's interest in being on a schedule for two members to be at the Shelter at a regularly scheduled time i.e., one hour a week/month to meet with providers or clients about NA. We agreed to follow up on this possibility. We have an opportunity to have a booth at the Kansas Prevention Conference at WSU on 10/16 and 10/17. There is a \$300 charge for a booth. We are asking the Region for their involvement or to cover the booth fee. Also, we are looking for banners/signage for events like this.

First and foremost I want to express my gratitude for being chosen for this role and for the opportunity to experience this year's Interim WSC, here are some highlights.

Interim WSC Feb 28th 2025

CONFERENCE FIRSTS

Interim WSC 2025 was the first . . .

- intentional virtual Interim WSC meeting.
- WSC meeting to review an interim strategic plan draft. Conference participants reviewed the key result areas, issues, and objectives. The solutions have not been drafted yet.
- WSC meeting with a majority of seated participants from outside the US (although 5 non US participants were not present.)

STATISTICS ON PARTICIPANTS ATTENDING INTERIM WSC 2025

- There were 144 voting members participating at this WSC—129 delegates and 15 World Board members. In addition, there were 89 alternate delegates, plus 4 HRP

members, 2 cofacilitators, and 8 translators.

- We also enlisted 15 volunteers, most former world level trusted servants, to help facilitate and take notes in the breakout rooms on day two of the conference.
- Of 128 seated regions, there were 123 RDs participating. Of 6 seated zones, 6 ZDs were participating.
- This was the first WSC that Brazil Central Region, Iran Region #1, Nordeste Brazil Region, Rio Grande do Sul Region, and Thailand Region participated as seated members.
- Baja Son, El Salvador, Nicaragua, Quebec, and Venezuela were not in attendance.
- Of the 129 delegates from seated regions and zones participating, 66 were from the US, 4 from Canada, and 59 from outside the US and Canada.
- We had 89 alternate delegates from seated regions or zones participating, 45 from the US, 3 from Canada, and 41 from outside of the US or Canada.
- This year's conference participants were from 44 countries.
